## **Eastside Bus Changes**

The tamariki who live on the Eastside bus run will be dropped off as follows. Those living on the left hand side of Te Ngae road will be dropped off first. The bus will continue to Ngapuna and then come up Te Ngae road heading towards school dropping the tamariki off who live on the opposite side of the road. Due to this change you tamariki may be a little early or late so please be patient. This change should be safer as there should be no need for tamariki to cross any roads.
